Officials with the Laurens County Schools in Dublin, Georgia, are closely monitoring the current situation as Hurricane Irma approaches the U.S. Mainland. As has been the case for several years, the school district works with local and state emergency management officials and the American Red Cross as our schools are typically called upon to serve as emergency evacuation shelters.

With the ordered evacuation of numerous counties in Georgia and Florida, we anticipate that several of our schools will be opened as EMERGENCY Red Cross shelters within the next 48 hours.

While no definite plans have been made at this hour to close our schools, we want our parents and employees to be prepared and on notice that this status could change. Please do what you can to have a plan in place should we need to close school.

We will keep our district and school webpages, our facebook page, and our media outlets informed of any changes.
