

Laurens County Board of Education 2018-2019 School Year Pre-Kindergarten Selection Process

DUE TO LIMITED SPOTS

The Laurens County Board of Education will hold a drawing to randomly select students for the Pre-Kindergarten program for the 2018-2019 school year.

Eligible Applicants:

- Child must turn 4 years old on or before September 1, 2018,
- Current Georgia Residents – Proof of residency is required.

Applications will be accepted from both in-district AND out-of-district families for the 2018-2019 school year. First priority will be given to those residing within the Laurens County School District.

ONLY in-district applicant names will be entered into the drawing on March 29.
(Out-of-district applicants will be notified of acceptance status after May 1, 2018)

Applications Accepted:

Applications will only be accepted at the schools during the following dates and times:

March 12 – 15, 2018 and March 19 – 22, 2018 from 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

(Applicants can only register at one school.)

*Applications will NOT be accepted after 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 22, 2018.

Required Documentation with Applications:

- Certified, legal copy of the child's birth certificate
- Copy of the child's social security card
- Picture ID of parent/guardian registering child
- LEGAL guardianship/custody papers must be presented if applicable
- Proof of Georgia residency (see below)
- Form 3231 Certificate of Immunizations * (see note below)
- Form 3300 Certificate of Eye, Ear, Dental & Nutrition* (see note below)

*Children who are four years old at the time of registration should submit these forms during registration, all others will be required to submit these once the child turns four.

Acceptable proof of residency (you must submit ONE of the following):

- Current utility bill (electric, water, gas ONLY) – Phone, cable, satellite & insurance bills will not be accepted
- Current mortgage statement
- Rent receipt on company letterhead (no handwritten receipts),
- Current signed lease agreement on company letterhead (no generic lease agreements) – must have been *executed* within the last 30 days.
- Property tax bill signed by the tax assessor's office.

Proof of residency MUST be in the parent/legal guardian's name. Any family who resides with another family member/individual and does not have proof of residency in the parent/guardian's name must also complete The *Laurens County Verification of Address Notarized Letter*. All documentation for proof of residency must be dated within the last 30 days to be accepted and must include the physical address of the property.
