Our Vision

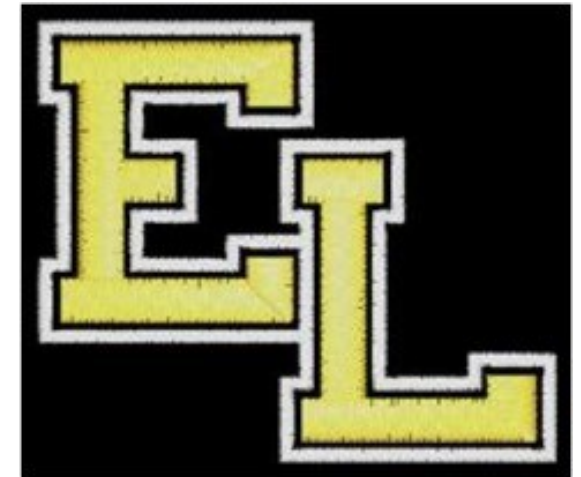
At East Laurens High School, we believe:
