**What is it?**

This is a plan that describes how WLHS will provide opportunities to improve family engagement in order to support student learning. WLHS values the contributions and involvement of parents and family members for establishing an equal partnership for the common goal of improving student achievement. This plan describes different ways that WLHS will support family engagement. It also provides information on ways parents can plan and participate in activities/events that promote student learning at school and at home.

**How is it revised?**

WLHS solicits input regarding the plan from teachers, students, and parents alike. All feedback is considered when revising the plan for the following school year. The plan is posted on our school website for students and parents to view and to provide feedback on throughout the year. We also distribute an annual survey online and provide printed surveys asking parents for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Parents and family members can also give feedback during our Annual Spring Title 1 Meeting.

**Who is it for?**

All students and their families are invited and encouraged to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. WLHS provides necessary resources for parents and family members with limited English, disabilities, and migratory children that will allow them the opportunity to fully participate as well.

## 2021-22 LCBOE District Goals

In our efforts to increase **rigor** and student achievement, to provide **relevant** curriculum learning experiences, and to build meaningful **relationships** with our students and stakeholders, the Laurens County School System has set the following goals for FY22:

**Goal 1:** Increase percentage of students reading on grade level based on Reading Inventory Lexile levels from the 2021-2022 beginning of the school year data so that at least 75% of students are considered proficient at the end of the 2021-2022 school year.

**Goal 2:** During FY22, Increase the number of students scoring on the Math GMAS at a proficient or distinguished level to pre-Covid percentiles.

**Goal 3:** Increase FY22 percentage of all subgroup populations scoring at the proficient level on GMAS ELA and MATH Assessments by 3% over FY21 scores

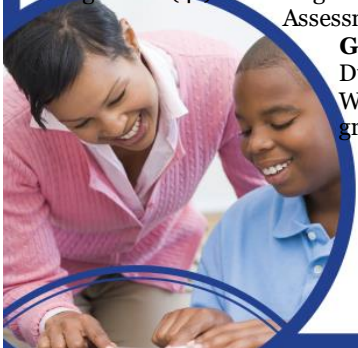
**Goal 4:** Increase or maintain school climate ratings at each school by utilizing support resources available.

## 2021-22 WLHS Goals

**Goal 1:** During the FY22 school year, WLHS will improve student achievement as evidenced by a 3% increase in the percentage of students scoring proficient (3s) or distinguished (4s) on the American Literature, Biology and U.S. History Georgia Milestone Assessments and by the increase of students reading on grade level (stretch band midpoint) as measured by Lexile scores on the American Literature test.

**Goal 2:** During the FY22 school year, WLHS will improve student achievement as evidenced by a 3% increase in the percentage of students scoring proficient (3s) or distinguished (4s) on the Algebra 1 Georgia Milestone Assessment.

**Goal 3:** During the FY22 school year, WLHS will increase the graduation rate by 2%.
