# **School Plan for Shared Student Achievement**

#### What is it?

This is a plan that describes how West Laurens High will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to support student learning. #### Open House

Meet your student's teacher and our friendly and helpful school staff for the year.

#### Grade Level Parent Nights

#### Dual Enrollment Night

#### FASFA Workshop

This workshop's target audience is graduating Seniors and their families. It will help parents navigate the tricky task of applying for financial aid to attend colleges and universities.

#### Rising 9th Parent Night

This meeting is designed to help rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders transition to the high school level. There will be information concerning course and graduation requirements that new high school students need to know. Extracurricular activities such as sports and clubs will also be presented, so that students get a sense of how important a well-rounded educational experience is.
