	School	Family	Student
Positive	Provide students with appropriate reading material through the media center or online virtual libraries. Send spelling and/or vocabulary lists on Mondays. Send home Reading Inventory Parent Report. Provide math measurement games/activities.	Provide a quiet place for students to do homework, read each day and review vocabulary words each night. Use math in everyday experiences such as using a measuring tape together, discuss mileage when traveling and costs/change.	Read for at least 20 minutes daily and complete homework, including review of spelling and/or vocabulary words each night. Complete math homework and math activities provided by teacher.
Hard Working	Offer online support to parents. Feature research-based games, websites, and activities that can improve reading comprehension, vocabulary, and measurement skills.	Encourage child to use online learning tools and/or suggested games, websites, and activities as provided by the teacher.	Use online learning tools and/or suggested games, websites, and activities provided by the teacher to improve reading, vocabulary, and math.
Respectful	Communicate to parents what is taking place in the classroom weekly through newsletters and agendas. Encourage two-way communication through email, Remind 101, phone calls, Google classroom, etc. Invite parents to Parent Night for family learning activities and to visit the Parent Resource Center in the Media Center.	Communicate with teachers through Remind 101, email or notes with questions, concerns or needs for the student. Attend Parent Nights at school and utilize the Parent Resource Center when needed.	Write homework in agenda daily exactly as the teacher has it written on the board and share upcoming assignments and assessments with family. Use materials from Parent Nights or Parent Resource Center to develop better reading comprehension and practice with measurement.
Achievers	Utilize reading contracts to set goals for success in improving Lexile levels. Set personal math goals to improve BEACON and IXL scores for measurement.	Check the reading log weekly to ensure the student is working to improve his/her Lexile level. Monitor for IXL achievement.	Be aware of his/her reading goals and complete the requirements of the reading contract/log by reading EVERY day! Work towards math goals when completing BEACON and IXL.

Goals for Our Students

District Goals:

Reading: Increase percentage of students reading on grade level based on Reading Inventory Lexile levels from the 2021-2022 beginning of the school year data so that at least 75% of students are considered proficient at the end of the 2021-2022 school year.

Math: During FY22, increase number of students scoring on the Math GMAS at a proficient or distinguished level to pre-COVID percentiles.
