	School	Family	Student
Positive	Provide students with appropriate reading material through the media center or online virtual libraries to increase reading fluency, sight words, and vocabulary. Provide students with math games and activities to improve number recognition to 120.	Read together each night focusing on fluency, sight words, and vocabulary. Practice sight words, and blending using phonics skills. Point out numbers in everyday settings. Talk about those numbers.	Read every night and practice reading fluency and sight words. Ask parents to listen as you read aloud. Look for numbers and how numbers are used around you.
Hard Working	Offer online support to parents. Feature research-based games, websites, and activities that can improve reading fluency, sight words, and number recognition to 120.	Encourage child to use online learning tools and/or suggested games, websites, and activities as provided by the teacher.	Use online learning tools and/or suggested games, websites, and activities provided by the teacher to practice reading fluency, sight words, and number recognition to 120.
Respectful	Communicate to parents what is taking place in the classroom weekly through newsletters and agendas. Encourage two-way communication through email, text services, phone calls, Google classroom, etc. Invite parents to Parent Night for family learning activities and to visit the Parent Resource Center in the Media Center.	Review work on a regular basis in daily homework folder or on Google classroom. Communicate with teacher through email, text services, phone calls, Google classroom, etc. Attend Parent Nights scheduled during the year and reach out to Instructional Coaches or the Parent Resource Center for instructional materials when needed.	Do all homework assignments and bring home all communications to families. Use materials from Parent Nights or Parent Resource Center to practice reading fluency and number recognition with family.
Achievers	Set goals with the student to promote reading achievement and success. Provide materials for families to work on numbers at home.	Monitor progress toward reading goals and completion of homework assignments. Use number flash cards and play math games with student.	Be aware of reading and math goals and work to achieve success by reading as much as possible.

District Goals:

Reading: Increase percentage of students reading on grade level based on Reading Inventory Lexile levels from the 2021-2022 beginning of the school year data so that at least 75% of students are considered proficient at the end of the 2021-2022 school year.

Math: During FY22, increase number of students scoring on the Math GMAS at a proficient or distinguished level to pre-COVID percentiles.
