	School	Family	Student
Positive	Provide students with appropriate reading material through the media center or online virtual libraries. Supply families with spelling, vocabulary, and sight word lists. Provide math fact practice games.	Have students read book aloud to an adult and review word lists. Make it fun by taking turns reading, reading with a flashlight, reading to a stuffed animal, etc. Play math fact practice games.	Read aloud to an adult to practice fluency and comprehension. Study word lists. Play math practice games with family.
Hard Working	Offer online support to parents. Feature research-based games, websites, and activities that can improve reading fluency, sight words, and math fact practice.	Encourage child to use online learning tools and/or suggested games, websites, and activities as provided by the teacher. Use addition and subtraction flash cards and involve math in day-to-day conversations.	Use online learning tools and/or suggested games, websites, and activities provided by the teacher to practice reading fluency, sight words, vocabulary, comprehension, as well as math facts.
Respectful	Communicate to parents what is taking place in the classroom weekly through newsletters and agendas. Encourage two-way communication through email, Remind 101, phone calls, Google classroom, etc. . Invite parents to Parent Night for family learning activities and to visit the Parent Resource Center in the Media Center.	Communicate with teachers through Remind 101, email or notes with questions, concerns or needs for the student. Attend Parent Nights and visit the Parent Resource Center or reach out to Instructional Coaches for instructional materials when needed.	Share all communication with family and teachers to keep everyone informed. Use materials from Parent Nights or Parent Resource Center to practice reading fluency and math facts with family.
Achievers	Set reading and math goals with students to promote success in reading achievement and math fact fluency. Provide fluency passages, sight word lists and fact practice.	Check the reading log daily to ensure the student is working toward his/her goal. Talk to students about meeting their goals.	Read aloud for 15-20 minutes nightly. Be aware of reading goals and complete the requirements of the reading contract/log by reading EVERY day! Practice math facts.

District Goals:

Reading: Increase percentage of students reading on grade level based on Reading Inventory Lexile levels from the 2021-2022 beginning of the school year data so that at least 75% of students are considered proficient at the end of the 2021-2022 school year.

Math: During FY22, increase number of students scoring on the Math GMAS at a proficient or distinguished level to pre-COVID percentiles.

READING: Increase the % of proficient and advanced readers by 22% (Reading Inventory)
