Reading Focus: Comprehension	Provide students with appropriate reading material through the media center or online virtual libraries. Send vocabulary lists on Mondays. Send home Reading Inventory Parent Report. Utilize reading contracts to set goals for success in improving Lexile levels.	Provide a quiet place for students to do homework, read each day and review vocabulary words each night. Check the reading contract to ensure the student is working to improve his/her Lexile level.	Read for at least 20 minutes daily and complete homework, including review of vocabulary words each night. Be aware of his/her reading goals and complete the requirements of the reading contract by reading EVERY day!
Writing Focus: essay	Provide exemplars and writing rubrics for parents to know what is expected. Share student's writing with parents for better understanding of student achievement.	Review student's writing examples and compare with rubric. Talk about how to improve.	Share writing examples with parents and work to improve the quality of their writing.
Math Focus: Problem Solving	Provide problem solving games/activities. Set personal math goals to improve BEACON and IXL scores. Provide time in class for taking notes on how to complete homework and solve problems.	Have students explain what they are doing in math using their notes. Monitor for IXL achievement. Monitor online games to be those suggested by the teacher.	Work towards math goals when completing BEACON and IXL. Complete math homework and math activities provided by teacher. Take notes and be able to explain to parents what you are working on in math.
Other	Communicate to parents what is taking place in the classroom weekly through newsletters and agendas. Encourage two-way communication through email, Remind 101, phone calls, Google classroom, etc. Invite parents to Parent Night for family learning activities and to visit the Parent Resource Center in the Media Center. Demonstrate and encourage use of the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page to play online activities.	Communicate with teachers through Remind 101, email or notes with questions, concerns or needs for the student. Attend Parent Nights at school and utilize the Parent Resource Center when needed. Encourage my child to do online activities on the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page.	Write homework in agenda daily exactly as the teacher has it written on the board and share upcoming assignments and assessments with family. Use materials from Parent Nights or Parent Resource Center to develop better reading comprehension and practice with measurement. Practice online activities on the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page.

District Goals:

Reading: Increase percentage of students reading on grade level based on Reading Inventory Lexile levels from the 2022-2023 beginning of the school year data so that at least 75% of students are considered proficient at the end of the 2022-2023 school year.

Math: During FY23, increase number of students scoring on the Math GMAS at a proficient or distinguished level to pre-COVID percentiles or higher.

ELA: Increase the % of proficient and advanced readers by 24% (Reading Inventory)
