Reading Focus: Comprehension	Provide students with appropriate reading material through the media center or online virtual libraries. Set a reading goal with students and communicate this goal with parents.	Provide a quiet place for students to read for 30 minutes daily and have “Book Talks” with the student about what he/she is reading. Monitor progress toward reading goal.	Read for at least 30 minutes daily and talk about what is read with a family member.
Writing Focus: Conventions	Provide exemplars and writing rubrics for parents to know what is expected. Demonstrate and encourage use of the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page to play online activities with conventions.	Allow time for students to write at home and check rubrics for mastery. These writings can include lists, personal letters, notes for studying, etc. Encourage my child to do online activities with conventions on the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page.	Practice writing at home using correct capitalization, punctuation, and spelling (with grade level words). Practice online activities with conventions on the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page.
Math Focus: Math Facts	Provide math games/activities to improve math fact fluency in multiplication and division. Set goals with the student to promote math fact fluency. Demonstrate and encourage use of the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page to play online activities with math facts.	Play math fact games/activities with students. Monitor progress toward math fact goal. Encourage my child to do online activities with math facts on the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page.	Use math skills in games/activities provided by teacher. Work to meet math fact goal. Practice online activities with math facts on the LCSS Parent and Family Engagement Google Page.
Other	Communicate to parents what is taking place in the classroom weekly through newsletters and agendas. Encourage two-way communication through email, Remind 101, phone calls, Google classroom, etc. Invite parents to Parent Night for family learning activities and to visit the Parent Resource Center in the Media Center.	Communicate with teachers through Remind 101, email or notes with questions, concerns or needs for the student. Attend Parent Nights and visit the Parent Resource Center for instructional materials when needed.	Do all homework assignments and bring home all communications to families to keep them informed. Use materials from Parent Nights or Parent Resource Center to develop better reading comprehension and practice math facts with family.

District Goals:

Reading: Increase percentage of students reading on grade level based on Reading Inventory Lexile levels from the 2022-2023 beginning of the school year data so that at least 75% of students are considered proficient at the end of the 2022-2023 school year.

Math: During FY23, increase number of students scoring on the Math GMAS at a proficient or distinguished level to pre-COVID percentiles or higher.

School Goals:

READING: Increase the % of proficient and advanced readers by 24% (Reading Inventory)

Reading Focus: Reading comprehension (Lexile levels)

Writing Focus: Conventions of writing

MATH: Decrease the % of “support needed” category to less than 25% (BEACON Math)
