Laurens County Schools operate under the National School Breakfast Program Provision II Option. This option allows breakfast meals to be available to all students at no charge.

New federal regulations have required the Laurens County School District to establish a new procedure for meal charges. Meal charges cannot exceed \$10.00 for any student. An Alternative Meal will be served once this charge threshold is reached. An Alternative Meal consist of a sandwich and a carton of milk.

Child Find Procedures for Laurens County Schools

Child Find is the school system's attempt to locate any children (3-21) who are suspected of having a disability. Special education and/or related services may be recommended if a disability interferes with a child's learning. Speech/Language Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Occupational Therapy are some of the related services that may be offered.

When should a child be referred to Child Find?

- If there are birth complications or a medical condition that interferes with development and/or learning
- If a child appears to have social or emotional difficulties that interfere with his/her ability to learn
- If a child appears to learn more slowly than children his/her own age
- If a child has speech that cannot be understood by others
- If a child has difficulty seeing or hearing

Notice of Rights of Students and Parents Under Section 504

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, commonly referred to as "Section 504," is a nondiscrimination statute enacted by the United States Congress. The purpose of Section 504 is to prohibit discrimination and to assure that disabled students have educational opportunities and benefits equal to those provided to non-disabled students.

HB251 Laurens County Intra-district School Transfer Option

The Laurens County Board of Education, in compliance with House Bill 251 (HB251), has developed a process giving parents/guardians the option to request that their children attend any school within the school system based on *space availability*. In accordance with the law, Laurens County has developed a process for parents to exercise this school transfer option and a process to determine space availability.
