Laurens County School Nutrition Program provides free meals to children during the summer, ages 1-18. This summer, meals will be prepared and served at various county parks and community locations as well as various schools and churches. Each year, the U.S. Department of Agriculture partners with local organizations like the Laurens County Board of Education to provide free meals to children when school is out for the summer.

The Laurens County Summer Nutrition Program will operate the USDA Seamless Summer Nutrition Program again this year and thanks you for being a part of our program last year. Last summer, our program was able to provide over 49,000 meals throughout our great county!

This summer, our program will operate Monday through Friday, with a holiday closing on July 3 and 4. Breakfast, lunch, or evening meals may be served each day. **Meals will begin on Monday, June 5 and will conclude on Friday, July 14.**
